AEEC 1120	Intro to Agribusiness Management – Orientation to the Department of Agricultural and Agricultural Business. Students will discover the types of careers available to graduates.
AEEC 2110	Agribusiness Management Principles – Description and application of management and financial principles, market planning, and organization theory in small business situations.
AEEC 305 / MKTG 305	Marketing and Pricing Agricultural Products – Description of agricultural processes and functions; food production and consumption patterns; agricultural product prices; nature of competition in agricultural product markets; commodity markets. (Required course for undergraduate students)

AEEC 400	Seminar. Current topics and cases in the agribusiness literature stressing rigorous qualitative analysis of current problems and policy issues.
AEEC 425	Agribusiness Financial Management – Description and application of techniques and principles of financial management to problem situations faced by agricultural businesses, including financial statement development and analysis, capital budgeting, sources and costs of capital.
AEEC 451/ MKTG 451	Agribusiness Market Planning – Applications course where self-managed teams develop and present marketing plans for agribusiness firms. Emphasis on integrating the marketing mix, particularly promotional elements.
AEEC 506	Economic and Financial Analysis of Agribusiness — Course focuses on common analytical tools used to evaluate the economic and financial performance of businesses operating in the food and fiber supply chain. The course uses a combination of course discussions, assignments, and case studies to present the material critical to the successful management of agribusinesses. Topics include financial statements and analysis, financial planning/modeling, financial risk and risk management, the time value of money, and capital budgeting methods used in agribusiness.
AEEC / FIN 511	Advanced Futures and Options Markets – Advanced hedging and speculating strategies using futures and options contracts. Coverage includes interest rates, stock indexes, metals, currencies, livestock, and grains. Concepts of price analysis (technical and fundamental) and basis analysis; technical paper is required.
